- (b) (1) Except as provided in subsection (h) of this section, the recycled content percentage requirements for newspapers distributed in the State shall, on a statewide basis, be in accordance with the 3-YEAR recycled content percentage requirements specified in subsection (c) of this section for the calendar year REPORTING PERIOD.
- (2) In the year following any year REPORTING PERIOD in which the Secretary determines, based on the reports submitted under subsection (e) of this section, that the 3-YEAR recycled content percentage requirements specified in subsection (c) of this section have not been met on a statewide basis, each newspaper shall:
- (i) For newspapers distributed in the State, satisfy the 3-YEAR recycled content percentage requirement under subsection (c) of this section for the calendar year REPORTING PERIOD; or
- (ii) Pay the newsprint recycling incentive fee required under subsection (d) of this section for that ealendar year REPORTING PERIOD.
- (c) (1) To satisfy the recycled content percentage requirement of this section for a ealendar year <u>REPORTING PERIOD</u>, at least the percentage specified in paragraph (2) of this subsection, by weight, of the total newsprint used by the publisher during that ealendar year <u>REPORTING PERIOD</u> for newspapers distributed in the State shall be recycled materials.
  - (2) The recycled content percentage requirement is:
    - (i) 12% for 1992;
    - (ii) 12% for 1993;
    - (iii) 20% for 1994, 1995, 1996, 1997, 1998, and 1999;
    - (iv) 25% for 2000:
    - (v) 30% for 2001 and 2002;
    - (vi) 35% for 2003 and 2004; and
  - (vii) 40% for 2005 and all subsequent ealendar years REPORTING

## PERIODS.3

- (C) IN 2006 AND ALL SUBSEQUENT CALENDAR YEARS, BY WEIGHT 40% OF THE CUMULATIVE TOTAL OF NEWSPRINT USED BY PUBLISHERS DURING THE CALENDAR YEAR AND THE PREVIOUS 2 CALENDAR YEARS FOR NEWSPAPERS DISTRIBUTED IN THE STATE SHALL BE RECYCLED MATERIALS.
- (d) (1) (H) [The] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE newsprint recycling incentive fee for any ealendar year REPORTING PERIOD is \$10 for each ton of a publisher's recycled content deficiency for the [year] 3-YEAR MEASURING PERIOD REPORTING PERIOD, as determined under [paragraph (2) of this subsection] SUBPARAGRAPH (II) OF THIS PARAGRAPH.
