S.B. 352 VETOES

In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, today I have vetoed Senate Bill 352 – Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loan of 2005 – Prince George's County – South County Sports and Technology Learning Complex.

This bill amends the Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loan of 2005 to change the name of the grantee for the South County Sports and Technology Learning Complex from the Advisory Committee Group for the South County Sports and Technology Learning Complex to the Maryland–National Capital Park and Planning Commission.

House Bill 1607, which was passed by the General Assembly and allowed to go into effect without my signature, accomplishes the same purpose. Therefore, it is not necessary for me to sign Senate Bill 352.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
