- (V) EMPLOYMENT AND CHARACTER REFERENCES; AND
- (VI) OTHER EVIDENCE THAT DEMONSTRATES THAT THE LICENSEE DOES NOT POSE A THREAT TO THE PUBLIC HEALTH OR SAFETY.
- (3) THE BOARD MAY NOT RENEW A LICENSE IF THE CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORD INFORMATION REQUIRED UNDER § 8–303 OF THIS SUBTITLE HAS NOT BEEN RECEIVED.

- (a) The Board may issue a temporary license to any applicant who:
- (1) SUBMITS TO A CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORDS CHECK IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 8–303 OF THIS SUBTITLE;
 - (2) Is licensed by any other state; and
 - $\lceil (2) \rceil (3)$ Submits to the Board:
 - (i) An application on the form required by the Board; [and]
- (II) WRITTEN, VERIFIED EVIDENCE THAT THE REQUIREMENT OF ITEM (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION IS BEING HAS BEEN IS BEING MET; AND
