(B) THE PLAN SHALL:

- (1) PROVIDE A FRAMEWORK FOR THE COVERNOR'S OFFICE FOR CHILDREN <u>OFFICE</u> AND AGENCIES TO PROCURE RESIDENTIAL CHILD CARE PROGRAM SERVICES THAT MEET THE NEEDS IDENTIFIED IN THE PLAN;
- (2) PROVIDE THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION ON RESIDENTIAL CHILD CARE PROGRAMS:
- (I) THE LOCAL JURISDICTION COUNTY WHERE EACH PROGRAM IS OPERATED;
 - (II) THE PROVIDER FOR EACH PROGRAM;
- (III) THE ACTUAL CAPACITY AND UTILIZATION RATE FOR EACH PROGRAM;
 - (IV) THE AGES OF THE CHILDREN IN THE PROGRAM;
- (V) THE $\frac{\text{LOCAL JURISDICTION}}{\text{LOCAL JURISDICTION}}$ OF EACH CHILD IN THE PROGRAM;
- (VI) THE SERVICES <u>EACH-CHILD-REQUIRES</u> <u>CHILDREN REQUIRE</u> AND A DESCRIPTION OF HOW THOSE SERVICES ARE BEING PROVIDED;
- (VII) THE AGENCY THAT PLACED $\overline{\text{EACH-CHILD}}$ $\underline{\text{CHILDREN}}$ IN THE PROGRAM; AND
- (VIII) ANY OTHER INFORMATION THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE FOR CHILDREN OFFICE OR THE AGENCIES, PROVIDERS, OR LOCAL JURISDICTIONS COUNTIES CONSIDER RELEVANT;
- (3) IDENTIFY THE TYPES OF SERVICES NEEDED IN RESIDENTIAL CHILD CARE PROGRAMS AND THE ESTIMATED NUMBER OF CHILDREN REQUIRING THOSE SERVICES IN EACH LOCAL JURISDICTION COUNTY;
- (4) IDENTIFY THE LOCAL JURISDICTIONS <u>COUNTIES</u> WHERE THE SERVICES IDENTIFIED IN ITEM (3) OF THIS SUBSECTION ARE INSUFFICIENTLY SUPPLIED;
- (5) ESTABLISH AN INCENTIVE FUND FOR RESIDENTIAL CHILD CARE PROGRAM DEVELOPMENT IN THE LOCAL JURISDICTIONS COUNTIES IDENTIFIED IN ITEM (4) OF THIS SUBSECTION; AND
- (6) IDENTIFY THE REASONS CHILDREN ARE PLACED IN RESIDENTIAL CHILD CARE PROGRAMS OUTSIDE OF THEIR LOCAL JURISDICTION <u>COUNTY</u> IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 5–525 OF THE FAMILY LAW ARTICLE.
- (C) (1) THE PLAN SHALL BE ISSUED ON OR BEFORE JULY 1, 2006 AND UPDATED ON OR BEFORE JULY 1 OF EACH YEAR.
- (2) ON OR BEFORE JANUARY 1 OF EACH YEAR, THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE FOR-CHILDREN OFFICE SHALL, IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 2–1246 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, REPORT TO THE GOVERNOR, THE SENATE EDUCATION,
