

license to an applicant, reprimand a licensee, place a licensee on probation, or suspend or revoke a license if the applicant or licensee:

(26) Fails to allow an inspection under § 8-6B-06(10) and (11) of this subtitle; [or]

(27) Fails to cooperate with a lawful investigation conducted by the Board;

(28) PRACTICES ELECTROLOGY WITHOUT A LICENSE BEFORE OBTAINING OR RENEWING A LICENSE, INCLUDING ANY PERIOD WHEN THE LICENSE HAS LAPSED; OR

(29) AFTER FAILING TO RENEW A LICENSE, COMMITS ANY ACT THAT WOULD BE GROUNDS FOR DISCIPLINARY ACTION UNDER THIS SECTION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2006.
