12-308. STAFF.

(A) STAFF.

(1) AN AUTHORITY MAY EMPLOY:

(I) A SECRETARY, WHO SHALL SERVE AS EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR;

AND

(II) TECHNICAL EXPERTS AND OTHER OFFICERS, AGENTS, AND EMPLOYEES, PERMANENT AND TEMPORARY.

(2) AN AUTHORITY SHALL DETERMINE THE QUALIFICATIONS, DUTIES, AND COMPENSATION OF ITS EMPLOYEES.

(B) LEGAL SERVICES.

FOR LEGAL SERVICES, AN AUTHORITY MAY USE THE CHIEF LAW OFFICER OF THE POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OR MAY EMPLOY ITS OWN COUNSEL AND LEGAL STAFF.

(C) DELEGATION OF POWERS AND DUTIES.

AN AUTHORITY MAY DELEGATE TO ONE OR MORE OF ITS AGENTS OR EMPLOYEES THE POWERS OR DUTIES IT CONSIDERS PROPER.

12-309. LIABILITY OF COMMISSIONERS AND STAFF.

(A) STATUS OF COMMISSIONERS AND STAFF.

EACH COMMISSIONER, THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR, AND EACH EMPLOYEE OF AN AUTHORITY IS:

(1) A LOCAL OFFICIAL FOR THE PURPOSES OF TITLE 15, SUBTITLE 8, PART I OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE AND SUBJECT TO LOCAL ETHICS LAWS; AND
