

HOWARD COUNTY

**Bill No. 45-2005**

AN ACT amending the Howard County Zoning Enabling Act to require that individuals petitioning the Zoning Board hold their required Pre-Submission Community meetings at specified days and times.

[Section 16.205 of the Howard County Code – Amended]

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**Bill No. 58-2005**

AN ACT amending the Howard County Code to require that developers also notify the Howard County Zoning Counsel of all required Pre-Submission Community Meetings pertaining to proposed residential development and to provide that the County Council shall determine whether or not the Zoning Counsel shall attend these community meetings.

[Sections 16.128 and 16.1000 of the Howard County Code – Amended]

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**Bill No. 59-2005**

AN ACT establishing a property tax credit for real property that is used as an athletic field exclusively for amateur sports; establishing the terms, conditions, and duration of the credit; providing for an application procedure and administration of the credit; and generally relating to property tax credits for amateur sports fields.

[Section 20.125 of the Howard County Code – Added]

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**Bill No. 69-2005**

AN ACT codifying Chapter 95 of the 2005 Laws of Maryland that authorizes Howard County to adopt local legislation establishing a Howard County Revenue Authority; establishing a Howard County Revenue Authority; specifying the number of members on the Board of Directors; specifying the expiration dates of the initial terms of the members of the Board of Directors; requiring certain budget requests to be submitted to the County Executive; and generally relating to the Howard County Revenue Authority.

[Sections 25.101 through 25.111 of the Howard County Code – Added]

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**Bill No. 70-2005**

AN ACT authorizing the Howard County Housing Commission to make construction loans and long-term mortgages from bond proceeds in order to produce housing for persons of eligible income; authorizing the Howard County Housing Commission to acquire, develop or construct a commercial facility on the site of or adjacent to a housing project under certain conditions; and generally relating to powers of the Howard County Housing Commission.
