SECTION 6. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the publisher of the Annotated Code of Maryland, in consultation with and subject to the approval of the Department of Legislative Services, shall correct, with no further action required by the General Assembly, cross—references and terminology rendered incorrect by this Act or by any other Act of the General Assembly of 2006 that affects provisions enacted by this Act. The publisher shall adequately describe any such correction in an editor's note following the section affected.

SECTION 7. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Revisor's Notes, Special Revisor's Notes, General Revisor's Notes, captions, and catchlines contained in this Act are not law and may not be considered to have been enacted as a part of this Act.

SECTION 8. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That it is the intention of the General Assembly that, except as expressly provided in this Act, this Act shall be construed as a nonsubstantive revision, and may not otherwise be construed to render any substantive change in the law of the State.

SECTION 9. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2006.
