- (ii) Demonstrated competence in medical protocols as determined by the EMS Board; and
- (iii) Been examined by the EMS Board and certified as an EMT-A by the EMS Board.]
- [(8)](7) "Emergency medical technician-basic" (EMT-B) means an individual who has:
- (i) Completed an emergency medical technician-basic course approved by the EMS Board;
- $\mbox{\ \ }$ (ii) Demonstrated competence in medical protocols as determined by the EMS Board; and
- (iii) Been examined by the EMS Board and certified as an EMT-B by the EMS Board.
- [(9)](8) "Emergency medical technician—paramedic" (EMT-P) means an individual who has:
- (i) Completed an emergency medical technician-paramedic course approved by the EMS Board;
- (ii) Been tested and registered by the National Registry of Emergency Medical Technicians, Inc. as an emergency medical technician-paramedic;
- (iii) Demonstrated competence in medical protocols within this State as determined by the EMS Board; and
 - (iv) Been licensed as an EMT-P by the EMS Board.
 - [(10)](9) "First responder" means an individual who has:
