

- (i) A cardiac rescue technician;
- (ii) An emergency medical dispatcher;
- [(iii) An emergency medical technician–ambulance;]
- [(iv)] (III) An emergency medical technician–basic;
- [(v)] (IV) An emergency medical technician–paramedic; or
- [(vi)] (V) A first responder.

[(7) “Emergency medical technician–ambulance” (EMT–A) means an individual who has:

- (i) Completed an emergency medical technician–ambulance course approved by the EMS Board;
- (ii) Demonstrated competence in medical protocols as determined by the EMS Board; and
- (iii) Been examined by the EMS Board and certified as an EMT–A by the EMS Board.]

[(8)] (7) “Emergency medical technician–basic” (EMT–B) means an individual who has:

- (i) Completed an emergency medical technician–basic course approved by the EMS Board;
- (ii) Demonstrated competence in medical protocols as determined by the EMS Board; and
- (iii) Been examined by the EMS Board and certified as an EMT–B by the EMS Board.

[(9)] (8) “Emergency medical technician–paramedic” (EMT–P) means an individual who has:

- (i) Completed an emergency medical technician–paramedic course approved by the EMS Board;
- (ii) Been tested and registered by the National Registry of Emergency Medical Technicians, Inc. as an emergency medical technician–paramedic;
- (iii) Demonstrated competence in medical protocols within this State as determined by the EMS Board; and
- (iv) Been licensed as an EMT–P by the EMS Board.

[(10)] (9) “First responder” means an individual who has:

- (i) Completed a first responder course approved by the EMS Board; and
