

(2) THE PERSON EXAMINED SHALL PRESENT THE ADOPTED EXAMINATION REPORT TO ITS BOARD OF DIRECTORS AT THE NEXT REGULARLY SCHEDULED MEETING OF THE BOARD.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2006.

**(House Bill 168)**

AN ACT concerning

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
