SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Chapter 204 of the Acts of 2003

SECTION 12. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That:

- (3) (T) Cumberland Valley Technology Center. Provide a grant equal to the lesser of (i) \$200,000 or (ii) the amount of the matching fund provided, to the Board of Trustees of ABC Cumberland Valley Technology Center, L.L.C. for the acquisition, planning, design, repair, renovation, reconstruction, and capital equipping of the ~~former Maryland National Guard Armory~~ CUMBERLAND VALLEY TECHNOLOGY CENTER [at 328-330 North Potomac Street], LOCATED in Hagerstown, for use as a preapprenticeship and apprenticeship training center for the construction, maintenance, and industrial trades; ~~subject to the requirement that the grantee grant and convey an historic easement to the Maryland Historical Trust.~~ Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 12(5) of this Act, the matching fund may include real property, in kind contributions, or funds expended prior to the effective date of this Act (Washington County)..... \$200,000

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2006.
