- (I) A VEHICLE THAT HAS HAD ITS HORSEPOWER OR DIMENSIONS CHANGED; OR
- (II) A VEHICLE THAT HAS BEEN REMANUFACTURED OR RECONSTRUCTED AS A REPLICA OF AN ORIGINAL VEHICLE.
- (B) IF REGISTERED WITH THE ADMINISTRATION UNDER THIS SECTION, AN ANTIQUE MOTOR VEHICLE IS A CLASS R (ANTIQUE) VEHICLE.
- (C) (1) SUBJECT TO PARACRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, FOR EACH CLASS R (ANTIQUE) VEHICLE, THERE IS A ONETIME RECISTRATION FEE OF \$50.00.
- (2) RECISTRATION OF A CLASS R (ANTIQUE) VEHICLE UNDER THIS SECTION IS NOT TRANSFERABLE TO A SUBSEQUENT OWNER OF THE VEHICLE.
- (D) IN APPLYING FOR REGISTRATION OF AN ANTIQUE MOTOR VEHICLE UNDER THIS SECTION, THE OWNER OF THE VEHICLE SHALL SUBMIT WITH THE APPLICATION A CERTIFICATION THAT THE VEHICLE FOR WHICH THE APPLICATION IS MADE:
- (1) WILL BE MAINTAINED FOR USE IN EXHIBITIONS, CLUB ACTIVITIES, PARADES, TOURS, OCCASIONAL TRANSPORTATION, AND SIMILAR USES; AND
  - (2) WILL NOT BE USED:
    - (I) FOR CENERAL DAILY TRANSPORTATION; OR
- (II) PRIMARILY FOR THE TRANSPORTATION OF PASSENCERS OR PROPERTY ON HIGHWAYS.
- (E) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN § 13 936.1 OF THIS SUBTITLE, ON RECISTRATION OF A VEHICLE UNDER THIS SECTION, THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL ISSUE A SPECIAL ANTIQUE MOTOR VEHICLE RECISTRATION PLATE OF THE SIZE AND DESIGN THAT THE ADMINISTRATION DETERMINES:
- (F) UNLESS THE PRESENCE OF THE EQUIPMENT WAS SPECIFICALLY REQUIRED BY A STATUTE OF THIS STATE AS A CONDITION OF SALE WHEN THE VEHICLE WAS MANUFACTURED, THE PRESENCE OF ANY SPECIFIC EQUIPMENT IS NOT REQUIRED FOR THE OPERATION OF A VEHICLE REGISTERED UNDER THIS SECTION.
- (G) A VEHICLE REGISTERED UNDER THIS SECTION IS EXEMPT FROM ANY STATUTE THAT REQUIRES PERIODIC VEHICLE INSPECTIONS OR THAT REQUIRES THE USE AND INSPECTION OF EMISSION CONTROLS.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2006 January 1, 2007.
