(IV) ~~CONTACT INFORMATION FOR ALL LESSORS, LESSEES, SELLERS, AND BUYERS OF AGRICULTURAL LAND; AND~~

(V) ~~INTERNSHIP, APPRENTICESHIP, EMPLOYMENT, AND BUSINESS OPPORTUNITIES FOR FARMERS; AND~~

(2) PROMOTE THE LEASE OR SALE OF AGRICULTURAL LAND FROM RETIRING FARMERS TO BEGINNING FARMERS; AND

(3) ~~PROVIDE FARM SUCCESSION AND FARM TRANSFER ASSISTANCE AND RESOURCES TO FARMERS.~~

(4) ~~THE SECRETARY MAY ADOPT REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBTITLE.~~
