- (C) UNDER THE PROGRAM, <u>IF SUFFICIENT FUNDS ARE PROVIDED IN THE ANNUAL BUDGET</u>, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL:
- (1) MAINTAIN AN ON-LINE DATABASE CONSISTING OF TO SERVE AS AN ELECTRONIC BULLETIN BOARD FOR THE VOLUNTARY POSTING OF INFORMATION ON:
 - (I) AGRICULTURAL LAND AVAILABLE FOR LEASE;
 - (II) AGRICULTURAL LAND AVAILABLE FOR SALE;
- (III) ANY OTHER LAND AVAILABLE FOR AGRICULTURAL USE, LEASE, OR SALE; \underline{AND}
- (IV) CONTACT INFORMATION FOR ALL LESSORS, LESSEES, SELLERS, AND BUYERS OF AGRICULTURAL LAND: AND
- (V) INTERNSHIP, APPRENTICESHIP, EMPLOYMENT, AND BUSINESS OPPORTUNITIES FOR FARMERS; AND
- (2) PROMOTE THE LEASE OR SALE OF AGRICULTURAL LAND FROM RETIRING FARMERS TO BEGINNING FARMERS, AND
- (3) PROVIDE FARM SUCCESSION AND FARM TRANSFER ASSISTANCE AND RESOURCES TO FARMERS.
- (D) THE SECRETARY MAY ADOPT RECULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBTITLE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2006 July 1, 2007.

CHAPTER 162

(House Bill 190)

AN ACT concerning

Electric Generating Stations - Approval Process for Modifications - Permits to Construct

FOR the purpose of altering air quality permitting requirements under the authority of the Department of the Environment Public Service Commission for certain modifications to eertain electric generating stations; altering a certain definition; and generally relating to the authority of the Department of the Environment Public Service Commission and electric generating stations.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article - Environment Public Utility Companies
