- (E) THE DECISION OF THE COMPACT COMMITTEE AFTER A HEARING IS FINAL.
- (F) THE COMPACT COMMITTEE MAY:
- (5) (1) ENTER INTO CONTRACTS AND AGREEMENTS WITH GOVERNMENTAL AGENCIES AND OTHER PERSONS TO PROVIDE PERSONAL SERVICES FOR ITS ACTIVITIES AND SUCH OTHER SERVICES AS MAY BE NECESSARY:
- $\frac{(6)}{(2)}$  (I) CREATE, APPOINT, AND ABOLISH ALL THOSE OFFICES, EMPLOYMENTS, AND POSITIONS, INCLUDING AN EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR, USEFUL TO FULFILL ITS PURPOSES;
  - (II) PRESCRIBE THEIR POWERS, DUTIES, AND QUALIFICATIONS;
  - (III) HIRE PERSONS; AND
- (IV) PROVIDE FOR THEIR TERM, TENURE, REMOVAL, COMPENSATION, FRINGE AND RETIREMENT BENEFITS, AND OTHER CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT;
- (7) (3) BORROW, ACCEPT, AND CONTRACT FOR THE SERVICES OF PERSONNEL FROM ANY STATE, FEDERAL, OR OTHER GOVERNMENTAL AGENCY OR FROM ANY OTHER PERSON OR ENTITY;
- (8) (4) ACQUIRE, HOLD, AND DISPOSE OF ANY REAL OR PERSONAL PROPERTY BY GIFT, PURCHASE, LEASE, LICENSE, AND SIMILAR MEANS IN FURTHERANCE OF THE PURPOSES OF THIS COMPACT:
- (9) (5) CHARGE AND COLLECT A FEE, WHETHER FOR LICENSURE OR RENEWAL, FROM EACH LICENSE APPLICANT; AND
- (10)  $(\underline{6})$  RECEIVE ADDITIONAL FUNDS THROUGH GIFTS, GRANTS, AND APPROPRIATIONS.
- (B) (G) CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORD INFORMATION MAY BE RECEIVED AND REVIEWED ONLY BY THE OFFICIALS ON, AND EMPLOYEES OF, THE COMPACT COMMITTEE WHICH MAY BE USED ONLY FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS COMPACT.
- (C) (H) NO OFFICIAL OR EMPLOYEE OF THE COMPACT COMMITTEE MAY DISCLOSE OR DISSEMINATE CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORD INFORMATION TO ANY PERSON OR ENTITY OTHER THAN ANOTHER OFFICIAL ON, OR EMPLOYEE OF, THE COMPACT COMMITTEE.
- $\frac{\langle \mathbf{D} \rangle}{\langle \mathbf{I} \rangle}$  The compact committee, its employees, or its designee shall:
- (1) TAKE THE FINGERPRINTS OF EACH LICENSE APPLICANT ON A FINGERPRINT CARD OR BY ELECTRONIC OR OTHER MEANS AUTHORIZED BY THE FEDERAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION OR OTHER RECEIVING LAW ENFORCEMENT ACENCY IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROCEDURES IN § 11–312 OF THIS TITLE; AND
