SUBTITLE 4. SEXUAL OFFENDER ADVISORY BOARD.

1–401.

- (A) THERE IS A SEXUAL OFFENDER ADVISORY BOARD IN THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND CORRECTIONAL SERVICES.
 - (B) THE BOARD CONSISTS OF THE FOLLOWING MEMBERS:
- (1) THE SECRETARY OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND CORRECTIONAL SERVICES, OR THE SECRETARYS DESIGNEE;
- (2) THE DIRECTOR OF THE DIVISION OF PAROLE AND PROBATION, OR THE DIRECTOR'S DESIGNEE;
- (3) THE CHAIRMAN OF THE MARYLAND PAROLE COMMISSION, OR THE CHAIRMAN'S DESIGNEE;
- (4) THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE MENTAL HYGIENE ADMINISTRATION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE, OR THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S DESIGNEE;
- (5) THE SECRETARY OF STATE POLICE, OR THE SECRETARY'S DESIGNEE; AND
 - (6) THE FOLLOWING MEMBERS, APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR:
 - (I) A REPRESENTATIVE FROM A VICTIM'S ADVOCACY GROUP;
 - (II) A HEALTH CARE PROFESSIONAL WITH EXPERTISE IN MENTAL

DISORDERS;

- (III) A STATE'S ATTORNEY;
- (IV) A LAWYER WITH EXPERTISE IN CRIMINAL DEFENSE;
- (V) A SEXUAL OFFENDER TREATMENT PROVIDER;
- (VI) A POLYGRAPHER;
- (VII) A REPRESENTATIVE OF A LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT UNIT;

AND

(VIII) TWO CITIZEN MEMBERS.

- (C) (1) THE TERM OF A MEMBER APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR IS 4 YEARS.
- (2) THE TERMS OF THE APPOINTED MEMBERS ARE STAGGERED AS REQUIRED BY THE TERMS PROVIDED FOR MEMBERS OF THE BOARD ON THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF CHAPTER 4 (H.B. 2) OF THE ACTS OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE SPECIAL SESSION OF 2006.
