

Preface

After the General Assembly gathered sufficient signatures to convene a Special Session according to Article III, Section 14 of the Maryland Constitution, the Governor, acting under Article II, Section 16, by Executive Order 01.01.2006.05 called the General Assembly into a Special Session on Tuesday, June 14, 2006.

Pursuant to the provisions of Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, the Senate of Maryland and the House of Delegates overrode the gubernatorial vetoes of three 2006 Regular Session bills and one 2006 Special Session bill. In addition one Special Session bill was passed by both houses and signed by the Governor.
