**CHAPTER 172**

**(Senate Bill 772)**

AN ACT concerning

**Health Insurance - Substance Abuse Treatment - Copayments**

FOR the purpose of prohibiting an insurer, nonprofit health service plan, or health maintenance organization from charging a copayment that is greater than a certain amount for a certain substance abuse treatment; providing for the application of this Act; making this Act an emergency measure; and generally relating to health insurance copayments for substance abuse treatment.
