(2) Is exempt from all State and local taxes.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That on the effective date of this Act, all public school buildings in Baltimore City on property held under a clear deed and title by the Baltimore City Board of School Commissioners shall be transferred to the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore.

SECTION 3-2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2005.
