SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Health - General

19-1416.

- (a) In this section, "family council" means a group of individuals who work together to protect the rights of and improve the quality of life of residents of a nursing home.
- (b) (1) A family council for a nursing home may consist of the following members:
 - (i) Members of a resident's family; or
- (ii) An individual appointed by the resident, or if the resident is incapable of appointing an individual, an individual appointed by the resident's family.
- (2) (i) Subject to subparagraph (ii) of this paragraph, a family council may be created by the owner, operator, or staff of a nursing home.
- (ii) [In] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (3) OF THIS SUBSECTION, IN order to facilitate the development of a family council, the owner, operator, or staff of a nursing home may lead the family council for no longer than 6 months at which time the family council shall be led by a member of the family council.
- (3) ON THE <u>WRITTEN</u> REQUEST OF A FAMILY COUNCIL, THE NURSING HOME MAY ASSIST THE FAMILY COUNCIL IN THE ADMINISTRATIVE FUNCTIONS OF OPERATING THE FAMILY COUNCIL IN A MUTUALLY AGREED UPON MANNER.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2005.
