SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Public Safety

[Subtitle 2. Explosives Advisory Council.]

[11−201.

- (a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.
- (b) "Council" means the Explosives Advisory Council.
- (c) "Department" means the Department of State Police.
- (d) (1) "Explosives" means chemical compounds, mixtures, or devices, the primary purpose of which is to function by explosion.
 - (2) "Explosives" includes:
 - (i) dynamite;
 - (ii) other high explosives;
 - (iii) black powder;
 - (iv) pellet powder;
 - (v) initiating explosives;
 - (vi) detonators;
 - (vii) safety fuses;
 - (viii) squibs;
