CHAPTER 253
(House Bill 957)

AN ACT concerning

Children in Need of Assistance or Supervision - Notice of Truancy

FOR the purpose of authorizing the juvenile court to notify certain school officials of the fact that a child has been found to be in need of assistance or in need of supervision and has been committed to a certain custody or under a certain guardianship; prohibiting the notice to school officials from including a certain order or pleading; requiring certain school officials to ~~notify the juvenile court~~ give certain notice to a local department of social services or the Department of Juvenile Services on receipt of a certain report under certain circumstances; and generally relating to children in need of assistance and children in need of supervision.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
