(E) SUBJECT TO AVAILABLE FUNDING, THE COMMISSION SHALL PROVIDE SUBSIDIES TO COMMUNITY HEALTH RESOURCES FOR OFFICE-BASED SPECIALTY CARE VISITS, DIAGNOSTIC TESTING, AND LABORATORY TESTS.

SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- (A) IN THIS SECTION, "FUND" MEANS THE COMMUNITY HEALTH RESOURCES COMMISSION FUND.

- (2) THE TREASURER SHALL HOLD THE FUND  $\underline{SEPARATELY}$ , AND THE COMPTROLLER SHALL ACCOUNT FOR THE FUND.

- (4) MONEY COLLECTED FROM A NONPROFIT HEALTH MAINTENANCE ORGANIZATION IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 6-121 OF THE INSURANCE ARTICLE;
  - (4) (5) (2) INTEREST EARNED ON INVESTMENTS;
  - (6) (6) (3) MONEY DONATED TO THE FUND;
  - (6) (7) (4) MONEY AWARDED TO THE FUND THROUGH GRANTS; AND
- (7) (8) (5) ANY OTHER MONEY FROM ANY OTHER SOURCE ACCEPTED FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE FUND.
  - (E) (1) THE FUND MAY BE USED ONLY TO:
