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**CHAPTER 312**

**(Senate Bill 473)**

AN ACT concerning

**Student Health Promotion Act of 2005**

FOR the purpose of requiring certain county boards of education to include certain information in certain health instruction; ~~requiring certain county boards to establish a certain nutrition policy by a certain date; providing that a certain nutrition policy does not apply to certain foods and beverages; requiring the nutrition policy to be implemented by a certain school year; requiring certain county boards to provide the State Department of Education with a copy of a certain nutrition policy and to report certain modifications to the Department; requiring certain vending machines to have and use certain timing devices in accordance with a certain policy~~ *certain policies*; and generally relating to *health and* nutrition policies in public schools.
