induce, or solicit the other individual to participate in or prevent the other individual from leaving a criminal gang; prohibiting a person from using physical violence with the intent to coerce, induce, or solicit another to participate in or prevent the other from leaving a criminal gang; prohibiting a person from threatening to use or using physical violence with the intent to coerce, induce, or solicit an individual, or a friend or family member of an individual, to participate in or prevent the individual from leaving a criminal gang in, on, or within a certain distance of certain school property; establishing certain penalties for certain violations of this Act; providing for the application of certain provisions of this Act; prohibiting the merging of certain crimes; expanding the list of offenses for which a law enforcement agency making an arrest of a child enrolled in a public school system is required to notify the local superintendent to include certain offenses involving gang affiliation; defining certain terms; providing for the construction of this Act; and generally relating to criminal gang offenses.
