SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - State Government

2-10A-05.

- (A) IN THIS SECTION, "COMMITTEE" MEANS THE JOINT COMMITTEE ON ACCESS TO MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES.
 - (B) THERE IS A JOINT COMMITTEE ON ACCESS TO MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES.
 - (C) (1) THE COMMITTEE CONSISTS OF EIGHT MEMBERS.
 - (2) OF THE EIGHT MEMBERS:
- (I) FOUR SHALL BE SENATORS, APPOINTED BY THE PRESIDENT; AND
 - (II) FOUR SHALL BE DELEGATES, APPOINTED BY THE SPEAKER.
 - (3) OF THE FOUR SENATORS:
 - (I) TWO SHALL BE MEMBERS OF THE FINANCE COMMITTEE:
- (II) ONE SHALL BE A MEMBER OF THE BUDGET AND TAXATION COMMITTEE; AND
- (III) ONE SHALL BE A MEMBER OF THE EDUCATION, HEALTH, AND ENVIRONMENTAL AFFAIRS COMMITTEE.
 - (4) OF THE FOUR DELEGATES:
- (I) TWO SHALL BE MEMBERS OF THE HEALTH AND GOVERNMENT OPERATIONS COMMITTEE:
- (II) ONE SHALL BE A MEMBER OF THE APPROPRIATIONS COMMITTEE; AND
- (III) ONE SHALL BE A MEMBER OF THE ECONOMIC MATTERS COMMITTEE.
- (D) THE MEMBERS OF THE COMMITTEE SERVE AT THE PLEASURE OF THE PRESIDING OFFICER WHO APPOINTED THEM.
- (E) (1) FROM AMONG THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE COMMITTEE, THE PRESIDENT SHALL APPOINT A SENATOR TO SERVE AS THE SENATE CHAIR OF THE COMMITTEE, AND THE SPEAKER SHALL APPOINT A DELEGATE TO SERVE AS THE HOUSE CHAIR OF THE COMMITTEE.
- (2) THE SENATE CHAIR AND THE HOUSE CHAIR SHALL ALTERNATE ANNUALLY AS PRESIDING CHAIRS AND COCHAIRS OF THE COMMITTEE.
