- (H) THE COMMITTEE SHALL SUBMIT AN ANNUAL REPORT TO THE GOVERNOR AND, IN ACCORDANCE WITH \S 2–1246 OF THIS TITLE, TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, REGARDING:
- $\hspace{1.5cm}$ (1) SYSTEMIC BARRIERS TO ACCESS TO MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES; AND
 - (2) RECOMMENDATIONS TO MITIGATE THESE BARRIERS.

(Senate Bill 565)
