- [(i)] (L) (1) "Recycling" means any process in which materials that would otherwise become solid waste are collected, separated, or processed and returned to the marketplace in the form of raw materials or products.
 - (2) "Recycling" includes composting.
- [(j)] (M) "Recycling services" means the services provided by persons engaged in the business of recycling, including the collection, processing, storage, purchase, sale, or disposition of recyclable materials.
- [(k)](N) "Resource recovery facility" means a facility in existence as of January 1, 1988 that:
- (1) Processes solid waste to produce valuable resources, including steam, electricity, metals, or refuse-derived fuel; and
- (2) Achieves a volume reduction of at least 50 percent of its solid waste stream.
- [(1)] (0) (1) "Solid waste stream" means garbage or refuse that would, unless recycled, be disposed of in a refuse disposal system located in this State.
 - (2) "Solid waste stream" does not include:
 - (i) Hospital waste;
 - (ii) Rubble;
 - (iii) Scrap material;
 - (iv) Land clearing debris;
 - (v) Sewage sludge; or
- (vi) Waste generated by a single individual or business and disposed of in a facility dedicated solely for that entity's waste.
 - [(m)] (P) "White goods" includes:
 - (1) Refrigerators;
 - (2) Stoves;
 - (3) Washing machines;
 - (4) Dryers;
 - (5) Water heaters; and
 - (6) Air conditioners.
- [(n)](Q) (1) "Yard waste" means organic plant waste derived from gardening, landscaping, and tree trimming activities.
- (2) "Yard waste" includes leaves, garden waste, lawn cuttings, weeds, and prunings.
