- (4) FROM TIME TO TIME, WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE GOVERNOR, THE SECRETARY SHALL DESIGNATE A PUBLIC MEMBER OF THE COMMISSION TO SERVE AS CHAIRMAN.
 - (D) A MEMBER OF THE COMMISSION:
 - (1) MAY NOT RECEIVE COMPENSATION: BUT
- (2) IS ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES UNDER THE STANDARD STATE TRAVEL REGULATIONS. AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.
- (E) THE STATE ARTS COUNCIL SHALL PROVIDE STAFF SUPPORT FOR THE COMMISSION.

- (A) THERE IS A MARYLAND PUBLIC ART FUND.
- (B) THE PURPOSE OF THE FUND IS TO PROVIDE GRANTS TO STATE AGENCIES AND LOCAL GOVERNMENTS TO SATISFY THE GOALS OF FUNDS TO IMPLEMENT THE MARYLAND PUBLIC ART INITIATIVE PROGRAM.
- (C) THE FUND IS A SPECIAL, NONLAPSING FUND THAT IS NOT SUBJECT TO § 7–302 OF THE STATE FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT ARTICLE.
- $(\underline{\mathrm{D}})$ THE TREASURER SHALL HOLD THE FUND AND THE COMPTROLLER SHALL ACCOUNT FOR THE FUND.
- (E) THE PROCEEDS OF THE FUND SHALL BE INVESTED AND REINVESTED IN THE SAME MANNER AS OTHER STATE FUNDS.
 - (F) ANY INVESTMENT EARNINGS SHALL BE PAID INTO THE FUND.
 - (G) THE FUND CONSISTS OF:
 - (1) APPROPRIATIONS IN THE STATE BUDGET; AND
- (2) ANY OTHER MONEY FROM ANY OTHER SOURCE ACCEPTED FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE FUND.
 - (H) THE COMMISSION SHALL ADMINISTER THE FUND.
 - (I) MONEY IN THE FUND MAY ONLY BE EXPENDED TO:
 - (1) AWARD GRANTS FOR THE PROGRAM; AND
- (2) PAY THE COSTS NECESSARY TO ADMINISTER THE FUND. TO CARRY OUT THE PURPOSES OF THIS SUBTITLE.
- (J) EXPENDITURES FROM THE FUND MAY ONLY BE MADE IN ACCORDANCE WITH AN APPROPRIATION APPROVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY IN THE ANNUAL STATE BUDGET OR BY AN APPROVED BUDGET AMENDMENT.
