

(4) FROM TIME TO TIME, WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE GOVERNOR, THE SECRETARY SHALL DESIGNATE A PUBLIC MEMBER OF THE COMMISSION TO SERVE AS CHAIRMAN.

(D) A MEMBER OF THE COMMISSION:

(1) MAY NOT RECEIVE COMPENSATION; BUT

(2) IS ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES UNDER THE STANDARD STATE TRAVEL REGULATIONS, AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.

(E) THE STATE ARTS COUNCIL SHALL PROVIDE STAFF SUPPORT FOR THE COMMISSION.

4-6A-03.

(A) THERE IS A MARYLAND PUBLIC ART FUND.

(B) THE PURPOSE OF THE FUND IS TO PROVIDE GRANTS TO STATE AGENCIES AND LOCAL GOVERNMENTS TO SATISFY THE GOALS OF FUNDS TO IMPLEMENT THE MARYLAND PUBLIC ART INITIATIVE PROGRAM.

(C) THE FUND IS A SPECIAL, NONLAPSING FUND THAT IS NOT SUBJECT TO § 7-302 OF THE STATE FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT ARTICLE.

(D) THE TREASURER SHALL HOLD THE FUND AND THE COMPTROLLER SHALL ACCOUNT FOR THE FUND.

(E) THE PROCEEDS OF THE FUND SHALL BE INVESTED AND REINVESTED IN THE SAME MANNER AS OTHER STATE FUNDS.

(F) ANY INVESTMENT EARNINGS SHALL BE PAID INTO THE FUND.

(G) THE FUND CONSISTS OF:

(1) APPROPRIATIONS IN THE STATE BUDGET; AND

(2) ANY OTHER MONEY FROM ANY OTHER SOURCE ACCEPTED FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE FUND.

(H) THE COMMISSION SHALL ADMINISTER THE FUND.

(I) MONEY IN THE FUND MAY ONLY BE EXPENDED TO:

(1) AWARD GRANTS FOR THE PROGRAM, AND

(2) PAY THE COSTS NECESSARY TO ADMINISTER THE FUND. TO CARRY OUT THE PURPOSES OF THIS SUBTITLE.

(J) EXPENDITURES FROM THE FUND MAY ONLY BE MADE IN ACCORDANCE WITH AN APPROPRIATION APPROVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY IN THE ANNUAL STATE BUDGET OR BY AN APPROVED BUDGET AMENDMENT.
