- (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.
 - (2) "COMMISSION" MEANS THE STATE REAL ESTATE COMMISSION.
 - (3) "FUND" MEANS THE STATE REAL ESTATE COMMISSION FUND.
- (B) (1) THERE IS A STATE REAL ESTATE COMMISSION FUND IN THE DEPARTMENT.
- (2) THE FUND IS A SPECIAL, NONLAPSING FUND THAT IS NOT SUBJECT TO § 7–302 OF THE STATE FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT ARTICLE.
- (C) THE FUND CONSISTS OF FEES COLLECTED BY THE COMMISSION AND DISTRIBUTED TO THE FUND UNDER § 17–213 OF THE BUSINESS OCCUPATIONS AND PROFESSIONS ARTICLE.
- (D) (1) THE FUND SHALL BE USED TO COVER THE ACTUAL DOCUMENTED DIRECT AND INDIRECT COSTS OF FULFILLING THE STATUTORY AND REGULATORY DUTIES OF THE COMMISSION.
- (2) THE FOLLOWING COSTS MAY NOT BE INCLUDED IN THE DIRECT AND INDIRECT COSTS OF THE COMMISSION BUT SHALL BE-PAID FROM-THE GENERAL FUND OF THE STATE:
- (I) THE COSTS OF THE OFFICE OF ADMINISTRATIVE HEARINGS THAT ARE ATTRIBUTABLE TO CASES REFERRED BY THE COMMISSION: AND
