BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Chapter 216 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2000 Section 2

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- (a) There is an Oversight Committee on Quality of Care in Nursing Homes AND ASSISTED LIVING FACILITIES.

 - (4) The Secretary of the Department of Aging;
- (5) The Secretary of the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene, or the Secretary's designee;
- (6) ONE REPRESENTATIVE FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE'S MENTAL HYGIENE ADMINISTRATION;
- (6) (7) THE SECRETARY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN RESOURCES, OR THE SECRETARY'S DESIGNEE;
- (6) (7) (8) Three representatives of area agencies on aging, ONE OF WHICH SHALL BE A MEMBER OF A LOCAL LONG-TERM CARE OMBUDSMAN PROGRAM ESTABLISHED UNDER ARTICLE 70B, § 5 OF THE CODE, appointed by the Secretary of Aging;
- (7) (8) (9) One representative from the Health Facilities Association of Maryland;
- (8) (9) (10) One representative from the Mid-Atlantic [Non-Profit Health and Housing Association] LIFESPAN;
 - (9) (10) One representative of the Hospice Network of Maryland;
 - (10) (11) (12) One representative of the Maryland Hospital Association;
- (11) (12) (13) One representative of the Service Employees International Union; [and]
