- (2) "PRIVATE RESIDENTIAL REHABILITATIVE INSTITUTION" MEANS A PRIVATE. NONPROFIT FACILITY THAT:
- (1) SERVES 150 OR MORE COURT-ADJUDICATED YOUTHS, INCLUDING YOUTHS IN THE CUSTODY OF THE DEPARTMENT;
- (2) (II) PROVIDES ACADEMIC, ATHLETIC, AND WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT SERVICES TO YOUTHS DESCRIBED IN ITEM (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION PARAGRAPH; AND
- (3) <u>IS-APPROVED ON OR BEFORE OCTOBER 1, 2005, TO SERVE YOUTHS</u> DESCRIBED IN THIS SUBSECTION.
- (III) HAS BEEN APPROVED TO SERVE YOUTHS DESCRIBED IN THIS SUBSECTION ON OR BEFORE OCTOBER 1, 2005.
- (3) "REVERSE-WAIVER JUVENILE" MEANS A JUVENILE CHARGED WITH A CRIME AS AN ADULT WHO IS LATER WAIVED BACK INTO THE JUVENILE SYSTEM UNDER \$ 4-202 OF THE CRIMINAL PROCEDURE ARTICLE.
- (B) (1) A PRIVATE RESIDENTIAL REHABILITATIVE INSTITUTION SHALL DEVELOP AN EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM.
- (2) SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION, THE EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM DEVELOPED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION BY THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION, A PRIVATE RESIDENTIAL REHABILITATIVE INSTITUTION SHALL IMPLEMENT THE EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM DEVELOPED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION.
 - (C) 'A PRIVATE RESIDENTIAL REHABILITATIVE INSTITUTION SHALL:
 - (1) RECEIVE STATEWIDE REFERRALS; AND
- (2) BE AN OPTION FOR THE PLACEMENT OF REVERSE-WAIVER JUVENILES WHO ARE CHARGED WITH A CRIME AS AN ADULT AND LATER WAIVED BACK INTO THE JUVENILE SYSTEM.
