- (i) Terminate the right of existing recipients to renew awards under § 18-704(d) of this subtitle; or
- (ii) If the recipient continues to teach in a public school in this State in that academic field, invoke the provisions of § 18-701(d)(1) of this subtitle or disqualify the recipient under the provisions of § 18-701(d)(2) of this subtitle.
- (h) Funds for the Teacher Education Tuition Assistance Program-shall-be as provided in the annual budget of the Commission by the Governor.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2005.

## CHAPTER 423

(House Bill 1236)

AN ACT concerning

Higher Education Community Colleges Students with a Documented Disability

## Community College Students with Disabilities Task Force

FOR the purpose of allocating a grant in a certain amount to the Maryland Higher Education Commission to be distributed to community college boards and to the Baltimore City Community College Board of Trustees on a certain basis; requiring the boards and the Board of Trustees to use the funds for a certain purpose; requiring the Commission, in consultation with the Maryland Association of Community Colleges, to adopt certain regulations for the administration of the grant; and generally relating to the funding of services and programs for students with a documented disability at both community colleges and the Baltimore City Community College.

FOR the purpose of establishing the Community College Students with Disabilities

Task Force; providing for the membership and staffing of the Task Force;
providing for the charge of the Task Force; requiring the Task Force to issue a
certain report by a certain date; providing for the termination of this Act; and
generally relating to students with disabilities attending community colleges in
the State.
