Community College Students with Disabilities Task Force

~~FOR the purpose of allocating a grant in a certain amount to the Maryland Higher Education Commission to be distributed to community college boards and to the Baltimore City Community College Board of Trustees on a certain basis; requiring the boards and the Board of Trustees to use the funds for a certain purpose; requiring the Commission, in consultation with the Maryland Association of Community Colleges, to adopt certain regulations for the administration of the grant; and generally relating to the funding of services and programs for students with a documented disability at both community colleges and the Baltimore City Community College.~~

FOR the purpose of establishing the Community College Students with Disabilities Task Force; providing for the membership and staffing of the Task Force; providing for the charge of the Task Force; requiring the Task Force to issue a certain report by a certain date; providing for the termination of this Act; and generally relating to students with disabilities attending community colleges in the State.
