- (b) A unit of the State government may not issue any license or permit to any person to conduct any activity within the Heritage Area unless the unit determines that the proposed activity:
- (2) As determined under [§§ 5-425 and 5-426 of the Housing and Community Development Article] §§ 5A-325 AND 5A-326 OF THE STATE FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT ARTICLE, does not have an adverse effect on the historic resources of the Heritage Area.

- (a) The Authority consists of:

 - (3) The Secretary of Higher Education;
