(g) (1) A custodian may deny inspection of a public record that contains information concerning the site-specific location of an endangered or threatened species of plant or animal, a species of plant or animal in need of conservation, a cave, or a historic property as defined in [§ 5-401 of the Housing and Community Development Article] § 5A-301 OF THE STATE FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT ARTICLE.

### **Article - Tax - General**

(a) An individual or corporation may claim a credit against the State income tax for a certified rehabilitation as provided under [§ 5-403 of the Housing and Community Development Article] § 5A-303 OF THE STATE FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT ARTICLE.

(b) An individual or corporation that is not otherwise required to file an income tax return, including a corporation exempt from income tax under § 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code:

(2) shall file a return if the individual or corporation is subject to the recapture of the credit under this section as provided under [§ 5-403 of the Housing and Community Development Article] § 5A-303 OF THE STATE FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT ARTICLE.
