

(vi) Continuation in placement for a specified period because of the child's special needs or circumstances; or

(vii) Independent living] ANOTHER PLANNED PERMANENT LIVING ARRANGEMENT THAT:

1. ADDRESSES THE INDIVIDUALIZED NEEDS OF THE CHILD, INCLUDING THE CHILD'S EDUCATIONAL PLAN, EMOTIONAL STABILITY, PHYSICAL PLACEMENT, AND SOCIALIZATION NEEDS; AND

2. INCLUDES GOALS THAT PROMOTE THE CONTINUITY OF RELATIONS WITH INDIVIDUALS WHO WILL FILL A LASTING AND SIGNIFICANT ROLE IN THE CHILD'S LIFE; and

(i) (1) In this subsection, "preadoptive parent" means an individual whom a child placement agency, as defined in [§ 5-301] § 5-101 of the Family Law Article, approves to adopt a child who has been placed in the individual's home for adoption before the [final decree] ORDER of adoption.

(b) (2) The purpose of the Program is to provide volunteers whose primary purpose is to ensure [that children who are the subject of a CINA proceeding are provided with] THE PROVISION OF appropriate service and case planning [that is in their] CONSISTENT WITH THE best [interest] INTERESTS OF A CHILD WHO IS THE SUBJECT OF:

(I) A CINA PROCEEDING; OR

(II) A GUARDIANSHIP REVIEW PROCEEDING UNDER TITLE 5, SUBTITLE 3 OF THE FAMILY LAW ARTICLE.

(r) A prosecution for an offense [of unlawfully charging or receiving compensation in connection with an adoption] under [§ 5-327] § 5-362, § 5-3A-45, OR § 5-3B-32 of the Family Law Article AS TO UNLAWFULLY CHARGING OR RECEIVING COMPENSATION IN CONNECTION WITH ADOPTION shall be instituted within 3 years after the offense was committed.
