NOTICE UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL BE BY FIRST CLASS MAIL.

(C) PARENTAL ADDRESS.

NOTICE UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL BE SENT TO A PARENT'S LAST ADDRESS KNOWN TO THE JUVENILE COURT.

5-316. ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE.

(A) REQUIREMENT.

PROMPTLY AFTER A PETITION FOR GUARDIANSHIP IS FILED UNDER THIS PART II OF THIS SUBTITLE, A JUVENILE COURT SHALL ISSUE A SHOW CAUSE ORDER THAT REQUIRES THE PARTY TO WHOM IT IS ISSUED TO RESPOND AS REQUIRED UNDER THE MARYLAND RULES.

(B) SERVICE.

ON ISSUANCE OF A SHOW CAUSE ORDER AS TO GUARDIANSHIP OF A CHILD, A PETITIONER SHALL SERVE THE ORDER ON:

(1) EACH OF THE CHILD'S LIVING PARENTS WHO HAS NOT CONSENTED TO THE GUARDIANSHIP;

(2) EACH LIVING PARENT'S LAST ATTORNEY OF RECORD IN THE CINA CASE; AND

(3) THE CHILD'S LAST ATTORNEY OF RECORD IN THE CINA CASE.
