- 3. C. representatives of the academic community with specialized knowledge of the Holocaust or genocide studies.
  - (2) The members of the Task Force shall be residents of the State.
  - (c) The Governor shall designate the chair of the Task Force.
  - (d) The University System of Maryland shall provide staff for the Task Force.
  - (e) A member of the Task Force:
    - (1) may not receive compensation; but
- (2) is entitled to reimbursement for expenses under the Standard State Travel Regulations, as provided in the State budget.
  - (f) (1) The Task Force shall:
- (1) <u>shall</u> advise the University System of Maryland regarding the establishment of a pilot program at a campus chosen by the Board of Regents that creates a Center for Excellence on the Study of the Holocaust, Genocide, Human Rights, and Tolerance that promotes education regarding the Holocaust, genocide, human rights, and tolerance; and
  - (2) may make recommendations regarding:
- (i) course content and other curricular materials for the effective teaching of the Holocaust, genocide, human rights; and tolerance; and
- (ii) training activities and exercises for teachers to effectively teach about the Holocaust, genecide, human rights, and tolerance.
  - (2) The Task Force may examine:
- (i) current course offerings on the subjects of the Holocaust, genocide, human rights, and tolerance at constituent institutions of the University System of Maryland;
- (ii) academic approaches taken in other states for the effective teaching of the Holocaust, genocide, human rights, and tolerance;
- (iii) national best practices regarding training activities and exercises for public school teachers to effectively teach about the Holocaust, genocide, human rights, and tolerance; and
- (iv) possible sources of funds to establish and sustain a Center for Excellence on the Study of the Holocaust, Genocide, Human Rights, and Tolerance.
- (3) The Task Force may not make recommendations regarding mandatory course content or curricular materials for the University System of Maryland or public schools.
- (g) The Task Force shall submit to the Governor and, in accordance with § 2–1246 of the State Government Article, the General Assembly:
