(2) A PUBLIC INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION, IF THE INFORMATION IS PART OF AN ARRANGEMENT BETWEEN THE INSTITUTION AND THE PRIVATE SECTOR IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE INSTITUTION'S ACTIVITIES UNDER § 15–107 OF THE EDUCATION ARTICLE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2005.

## **CHAPTER 486**

(Senate Bill 510)

AN ACT concerning

## Law Enforcement Officers' Pension System - Membership - Aviators with the Department of State Police

FOR the purpose of providing certain aviators who are employed by the Department of State Police to operate an aircraft for the State Emergency Medical System with membership in the Law Enforcement Officers' Pension System; making membership optional for certain aviators; and generally relating to retirement benefits for aviators who operate aircraft for the State Emergency Medical System.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## **Article - State Personnel and Pensions**

26 - 201.

- (a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, this subtitle applies only to:
- (1) an employee of the Department of Natural Resources commissioned by the Secretary of Natural Resources as:
  - (i) a Natural Resources police officer; or
- (ii) a law enforcement officer, other than a Natural Resources police officer;
