AN ACT concerning

Baltimore City Sheriff - Employees - Salaries and Expense Allowances

FOR the purpose of altering the salaries of certain employees of the Baltimore City Sheriff; altering certain surcharges on filing fees in the District Court in Baltimore City; requiring certain revenue to be remitted quarterly to the Baltimore City Director of Finance and used to fund the salaries of certain employees of the Baltimore City Sheriff; altering the expense allowance amount received by a deputy sheriff; altering certain surcharges on filing fees in the District Court in Baltimore City; requiring certain revenue to be remitted quarterly to the Baltimore City Director of Finance and used for a certain purpose; providing for the funding of salaries of certain employees of the Baltimore City Sheriff; providing for the termination of certain provisions of this Act; and generally relating to the salaries and expense allowances of employees of the Baltimore City Sheriff.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
