- (I) HAVE THE POWERS GRANTED TO A POLICE OFFICER UNDER § 7-207 OF THE TRANSPORTATION ARTICLE: AND
- (II) TRANSFER TO THE LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS' PENSION SYSTEM ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 31, 2005.
- (2) THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES SHALL TRANSFER TO THE ACCUMULATION FUND OF THE LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS' PENSION SYSTEM THE EMPLOYER CONTRIBUTIONS MADE TO THE PENSION SYSTEM UNDER § 7 603 OF THE TRANSPORTATION ARTICLE ON BEHALF OF THOSE MEMBERS UNDER PARACRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION, PLUS THE INTEREST EARNED ON THOSE CONTRIBUTIONS THROUGH THE DATE OF TRANSFER.
- (D) (1) ON OR BEFORE JANUARY 1, 2006, FOR MEMBERS WHO TRANSFER FROM THE MARYLAND TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION PENSION SYSTEM ESTABLISHED UNDER § 7-603 OF THE TRANSPORTATION ARTICLE, THE MARYLAND TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION SHALL TRANSFER TO THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES THE EMPLOYER CONTRIBUTIONS MADE TO THE PENSION SYSTEM ESTABLISHED UNDER § 7-603 OF THE TRANSPORTATION ARTICLE ON BEHALF OF THOSE MEMBERS WHO TRANSFER PLUS THE INTEREST EARNED ON THOSE CONTRIBUTIONS THROUGH JULY 1, 2005.
- (2) THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES SHALL DEPOSIT ANY FUNDS TRANSFERRED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION IN THE ACCUMULATION FUND OF THE LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS' PENSION SYSTEM.

- (A) THIS SECTION APPLIES TO A  $\frac{1}{2}$  MEMBER OF THE  $\frac{1}{2}$  MARYLAND TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION POLICE FORCE WHO:
- (1) HAS THE POWERS GRANTED TO A POLICE OFFICER UNDER  $\S$  7–207 OF THE TRANSPORTATION ARTICLE; AND
- (2) WHO TRANSFERS TO THE LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS' PENSION SYSTEM ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 31, 2005.
- (B) A MEMBER MAY TRANSFER THE MEMBER'S ELICIBILITY SERVICE RECOGNIZED UNDER THE PENSION SYSTEM UNDER \$ 7 603 OF THE TRANSPORTATION ARTICLE TO THE LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS' PENSION SYSTEM IF, WITHIN 1 YEAR AFTER BECOMING A MEMBER OF THE LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS' PENSION SYSTEM, THE INDIVIDUAL COMPLETES A CLAIM FOR THE SERVICE CREDIT AND FILES IT WITH THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES ON A FORM THAT THE ADMINISTRATOR PROVIDES.
- (C) A MEMBER SHALL DEPOSIT CONTRIBUTIONS IN THE ANNUITY SAVINGS FUND OF THE LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS' PENSION SYSTEM AT THE RATE OF 4% OF THE INDIVIDUAL'S EARNABLE COMPENSATION WHILE THE INDIVIDUAL IS A MEMBER OF THE PENSION SYSTEM UNDER § 7 602 OF THE TRANSPORTATION ARTICLE AFTER JULY 1, 2000, INCLUDING REGULAR INTEREST ON THE CONTRIBUTIONS AT THE RATE OF 5% PER YEAR COMPOUNDED ANNUALLY.
