$\lceil (15) \rceil (16)$ Worcester.

- (b) An individual subject to the authority of the county board may not serve as a member of the county board. At the time of filing a certificate of candidacy for election to a county board, a person shall certify to the local board of supervisors of election whether or not he is subject to the authority of the county board. The Governor shall not issue a commission of election to a person who has certified affirmatively and who is elected to a county board until the member-elect offers proof that he is no longer subject to the authority of the county board.
- (c) The election of the county boards shall be held as provided in Subtitles 2 through 13 of this title and the Election Law Article.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
