## **CHAPTER 542**

(House Bill 393)

AN ACT concerning

## Vehicle Laws - Minor Holding Provisional Driver's License Restriction for a Minor - Prohibition Against Minors as Passengers

FOR the purpose of requiring the Motor Vehicle Administration to impose a certain restriction on the original provisional driver's license of a minor that prohibits the prohibiting the holder of a provisional driver's license who is a minor from transporting individuals under a certain age as passengers except under certain circumstances; requiring the restriction prohibition to be in effect for a certain period of time; exempting certain passengers from the provisions of this Act; authorizing a police officer to enforce a violation of a restriction imposed under this Act only as a secondary violation; providing that a violation of a restriction imposed under this Act is a moving violation for the purpose of assessing points against a driver's license; authorizing the Motor Vehicle Administration to suspend or revoke an individual's driver's license under certain circumstances; and generally relating to a restriction on the original provisional driver's license of a minor prohibition imposed on a minor holding a provisional driver's license.
