- (I) IS AT LEAST 21 YEARS OLD:
- (II) HAS BEEN LICENSED FOR AT LEAST 3 YEARS IN THIS STATE OR IN ANOTHER STATE TO DRIVE VEHICLES OF THE CLASS THEN BEING DRIVEN BY THE HOLDER OF THE PROVISIONAL DRIVER'S LICENSE; AND
- $\underline{\rm (III)}$  IS SEATED BESIDE THE HOLDER OF THE PROVISIONAL DRIVER'S LICENSE.
- (2) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (3) OF THIS SUBSECTION, A HOLDER OF A PROVISIONAL DRIVER'S LICENSE WHO IS UNDER THE AGE OF 18 YEARS MAY NOT DRIVE A MOTOR VEHICLE WITH A PASSENGER UNDER THE AGE OF 18 YEARS.
  - (3) THE PROHIBITION UNDER PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION:
- $\frac{1\cdot}{1\cdot}$   $(\underline{\rm I})$  SHALL BE IN EFFECT FROM THE DATE THE PROVISIONAL LICENSE IS ORIGINALLY ISSUED UNTIL THE  $\frac{181ST}{151ST}$  DAY AFTER THE PROVISIONAL LICENSE WAS ISSUED; AND
  - 2. (II) DOES NOT APPLY TO A PASSENGER WHO IS:
- A. 1. A SPOUSE, DAUGHTER, SON, STEPDAUGHTER, STEPSON, SISTER, BROTHER, STEPSISTER, OR STEPBROTHER OF THE LICENSEE; OR
- $$B$\!-\!$  2 . A RELATIVE OF THE LICENSEE WHO RESIDES AT THE SAME ADDRESS AS THE LICENSEE.
- $\stackrel{\hbox{\scriptsize (2)}}{}$   $\stackrel{\hbox{\scriptsize (B)}}{}$  A POLICE OFFICER MAY ENFORCE A-RESTRICTION IMPOSED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION THIS SECTION ONLY AS A SECONDARY ACTION WHEN THE POLICE OFFICER DETAINS A DRIVER FOR A SUSPECTED VIOLATION OF ANOTHER PROVISION OF THE CODE.
- $\frac{(2)}{\text{CD}}$  A VIOLATION OF A RESTRICTION IMPOSED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION THIS SECTION IS A MOVING VIOLATION FOR THE PURPOSES OF  $\S$  16–402 OF THIS TITLE.
- $\frac{(D)}{OR} \; \frac{(1)}{EF} \; \frac{\text{IF THE ADMINISTRATION RECEIVES SATISFACTORY EVIDENCE THAT}}{EF} \; \frac{(D)}{EF} \; \frac{(D)}{EF}$
- (2) AN INDIVIDUAL MAY REQUEST A HEARING AS PROVIDED FOR A SUSPENSION OR REVOCATION UNDER TITLE 16, SUBTITLE 2 OF THIS ARTICLE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2005.
