3. FOR THE PURPOSE OF DRIVING TO OR FROM SCHOOL.

(2) AN INDIVIDUAL MAY REQUEST A HEARING AS PROVIDED FOR A SUSPENSION OR REVOCATION UNDER TITLE 16, SUBTITLE 2 OF THIS ARTICLE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2005.

CHAPTER 544

(Senate Bill 50)

AN ACT concerning

Motor Vehicles - Restrictions Learners' Permits and Provisional Licenses - Prohibition on Use of <u>a</u> Wireless Communication Devices <u>Device</u> While Driving

FOR the purpose of requiring the Motor Vehicle Administration to impose a restriction on each learner's instructional permit and provisional driver's license, and on certain driver's licenses, that prohibits permit holders or licensees prohibiting the holder of a learner's instructional permit or provisional driver's license from using a certain interactive types of wireless communication device devices while operating a motor vehicle that is in-motion; prohibiting the driver of a motor vehicle that is in motion from using an interactive wireless communication device that is held by the driver while in use; providing for certain exceptions; defining certain terms; establishing certain penaltics; prohibiting certain violations of this Act from being considered moving violations for certain purposes; providing that certain provisions of this Act supersede certain local laws, ordinances, or regulations; providing that certain provisions of this Act may only be enforced by certain measures during a certain period of time; providing for the construction of this Act; authorizing a police officer to enforce this Act only as a secondary action when detaining a driver for another suspected violation of law; authorizing the Motor Vehicle Administration to suspend an individual's driver's license for a violation of this Act for up to a certain period of time; authorizing the Administration to issue a certain restricted license; providing for certain hearings; and generally relating to prohibiting the use of certain interactive wireless communication devices in motor vehicles by holders of learners' instructional permits or provisional drivers' licenses under certain circumstances.
