

- (2) one member of the House of Delegates who serves on the Maryland General Assembly's Veteran's Caucus, appointed by the Speaker of the House;
 - (3) the Secretary of Veterans Affairs or the Secretary's designee; and
 - (4) the following members, appointed by the Governor:
 - (i) two representatives of the Maryland Veterans Commission; and
 - (ii) four representatives of women's veterans organizations.
- (c) The members of the Task Force shall elect the chairman from among the Task Force's members.
- (d) The Department of Veterans Affairs shall provide staff for the Task Force.
- (e) A member of the Task Force:
- (1) may not receive compensation; but
 - (2) is entitled to reimbursement for expenses under the Standard State Travel Regulations, as provided in the State budget.
- (f) The Task Force shall identify and recommend the funding, design, construction, and placement of an appropriate ~~memorial or~~ monument dedicated to women from Maryland who ~~lost their lives while serving~~ served in the ~~armed~~ uniformed forces of the United States of America.
- (g) The Task Force shall report its findings and recommendations to the Governor and, subject to § 2-1246 of the State Government Article, the General Assembly on or before December 31, 2005.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2005. It shall remain effective for a period of 6 months and, at the end of December 31, 2005, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.

CHAPTER 557

(House Bill 553)

AN ACT concerning

Anne Arundel County - Pretrial Release, Work Release, and Related Programs - Eligibility and Fees

FOR the purpose of altering the types of payments that the Administrator of the Anne Arundel County Department of Detention Facilities may deduct from earnings of certain participants in certain programs; authorizing the Administrator to deduct certain fees from the earnings of certain participants in certain work
