**CHAPTER 591**

**(House Bill 1057)**

AN ACT concerning

**Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission - Sewer Usage Charges**

**MC/PG 120-05**

FOR the purpose of authorizing, under the Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission (WSSC) law, certain properties to use a certain separate metered connection under certain circumstances; establishing methods for determining sewer usage charges for certain properties; making stylistic changes; and generally relating to sewer usage charges collected by the WSSC.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
